

A scavenger hunt

Definitions:

- **Long Shot** – Shows all of the subject and most of the surroundings.
- **Medium Long Shot**- Shows an Actor from his ankles up and some of the surroundings.
- **Medium Shot** – Shows an Actor from his waist up.
- **Medium Close-up** - Shows an Actor from his chest/shoulders up.
- **Close-up** – Shows an Actors face so that it takes up most of the frame.
- **Extreme Close-up** – Shows an Actors face taking up the entire frame.

Assignment:

I will divide you up in groups of four. Your group must find and shoot 5 seconds pre roll and 10 seconds roll for each of the following items and people then shoot 5 seconds of post roll. (Each member in the group must take turns and shoot at least two of the following items or people): Shoot at Eye or Item level!

1. Establishing Shot of the Main Office.
2. A Long Shot of an Administrator or Secretary at their desk.
3. A Medium Close up of an Administrator or Secretary at their desk.
4. Medium Shot of a Security Guard or Hall Monitor.
5. A Long Shot of a Student Standing in front of the Lion's Pride display case.
6. A close up of a lion.
7. An extreme close up of a students face.
8. An Establishing shot of a hallway with lockers.
9. A long shot of a student opening a locker.
10. An extreme close up of a combination lock being unlocked.
11. A Medium Shot of a student taking books out of his locker.
12. A Long Shot of a student tying his shoe.
13. A Medium Shot of the student tying the shoe.
14. A Close-up Shot of the student tying the shoe. Only Show the shoe and hands.
